	<p style="text-align: center;">Format</p> <p>Podcast meets or exceeds the time limit (at least 2 minutes).</p>	
	<p style="text-align: center;">Format</p> <p>The final podcast is uploaded to students' Google Drive folder.</p>	
	<p style="text-align: center;">Content</p> <p>The podcast topic is personal, interesting, and listeners can connect to it.</p>	
	<p style="text-align: center;">Content</p> <p>The podcast focuses on a <i>central</i> idea.</p>	
	<p style="text-align: center;">Content</p> <p>The podcast includes <i>specific</i> details and <i>rich</i> descriptions to help the listener "see" the story.</p>	
	<p style="text-align: center;">Content</p> <p>The podcast does not include unnecessary or unimportant information.</p>	
	<p style="text-align: center;">Content</p> <p>The podcast is organized well (includes introduction, story development, climax, conclusion).</p>	

	<p>Sound/Voice The podcast uses music <i>and</i> sound effects to communicate to the listener.</p>	
	<p>Sound/Voice The speaker talks clearly, at an appropriate pace (not too slow/not too fast), and with energy/emotion.</p>	
	<p>Sound/Voice The speaker doesn't repeat many words. Use synonyms.</p>
